1. I, the Parent or Guardian, agree that the participant(s) (children) and I shall comply with the stated and customary terms, rules and conditions for participation in any program provided by Rehoboth Baptist Church. In addition, if I/we observe any hazard during our participation, we will bring it to the attention of Rehoboth staff or volunteers.
2. I am aware that participation at the program mentioned above and/or use of any facilities and/or equipment creates a risk of injury, and I, on behalf of myself and the participants, knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of others; and,

I, for myself and the participant(s), and our respective administrators, personal representatives, and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless Rehoboth Baptist Church, Pastor and membership and their affiliates, officers, members, agents, employees, other participants, volunteers and sponsoring groups, from and against all claims, injuries, liabilities or damages arising out of, or related to participation in any and all Rehoboth facilities, activities, whether on or off site.

I have carefully read and fully understand the release and Waiver of Liability. I agree that any dispute, claim, questions, or disagreement arising out of or relating to said activities, events, retreats or trips, which can not be otherwise resolved shall be submitted to mediation and if necessary legally bringing arbitration as adopted by the Administrative Pastor and legal counsel. As a result, I expressly waive any and all rights at law and equity to bring any civil matter before a court of law; except that judgment upon the award rendered by the arbitrator may be entered in any court have jurisdiction thereof.
